Dear Dr. Chu,

Thank you for the copy of the DoDIG "Evaluation Report of the DoD Chaplain Program," and the DoD Instruction booklet. However, my questions were not answered. Below are several basic questions. Please do not send me any more reports, please send me answers to these questions. Thank you.

- 1) Have you gone back and identified the chaplains still serving in our military who were suggested for approval or placed into military service by the convicted terrorist, Abdurahman Alamoudi?
- 2) Have you re-vetted these chaplains to ensure they do not have the same ties and contacts with the same radical groups as Alamoudi?
- 3) What are the names of the groups and organizations the Department of Defense uses to recruit, or endorse, potential Muslim chaplains?
- 4) Does the Department of Defense still list the American Muslim Armed Forces & Veterans Affairs Council, which was founded by Alamoudi, as a religious organization that endorses Muslims for the Chaplain program?
- 5) Does the Department of Defense still accept Muslim chaplains who are associated with or attended the Graduate School of Islamic Social Sciences, who was raided after 9/11 for suspected terror-financing?
- 6) Does the Department of Defense still accept Muslim chaplains who are endorsed by, or associated with, the Islamic Society of North America, who is designated by the federal government as an "unindicted co-conspirator" in the Holy Land Foundation Trial for their criminal conspiracy to support Hamas?
- 7) How many Muslim chaplains are currently serving in the military, and what religious organization, or religious organization agent, endorsed them?
